

2025 Congressional

Art Competition

Congresswoman María Elvira Salazar is now accepting submissions for the 2025 Congressional Art Competition for high school students who are residents of Florida's 27th Congressional District.

Requirements

PARTICIPANTS: The Congressional Art Competition is open to all high school students (9-12th grade) who either reside or attend school in Florida's 27th Congressional District.

ART: The artwork, including the frame, may not exceed **15lbs** in weight or the following lateral dimensions: **26" x 26" x 4"**. Students may only submit two-dimensional artwork. Sculptures, masks, etc. are impermissible, even if they are less than 4" deep.

Prizes

FIRST PRIZE: The winning artwork will be displayed in the Cannon Tunnel at the Capitol for 11 months. A reception will be held in Washington, D.C. for all first-prize winners.

SECOND PRIZE: The runner-up artwork will be displayed in Congresswoman Salazar's Washington, D.C. office.

THIRD PRIZE: The second-runner-up artwork will be displayed in Congresswoman Salazar's Miami District Office.

Submission Process

To enter the competition, fill out the online form on our website and email RepSalazarMiami@mail.house.gov. All artworks and release forms must be submitted by **March 20, 2025** and dropped off at the **Miami District Office**.
